- Services&housing for international students
- Administration&coordination of students mobility
- Management of mobility educational projects
- Rector's Protocol
- Organizing incoming &outgoing visits
- Adminsitration&coordination of international agreements
- Coordination of FPs and other international research programs
- Training&consultancy for staff&students
- Travel service for staff & students





Task 5.2 Pilot activities raport

Each Israeli college will conduct 3 selected IRO activities, assisted by EU partners, within:

- 2 on-site visits (meeting at QSM and KC),
- 3 on-line conferences,
- On-going consultation via email
 The final WP5 raport will include best practices
 and guidelines





Task 5.3 Pilot summary meeting

- All partners meeting at BBC
- Gathering in one place all Colleges' IRO staff and their mentors to present the results of mentoring in up to 21 different IR activities
- Sharing experiences and best practices
- Recommendations from European mentors
