

WP3: 2nd Workshop on Internationalization of the curriculum

Evaluation report - practical arrangements

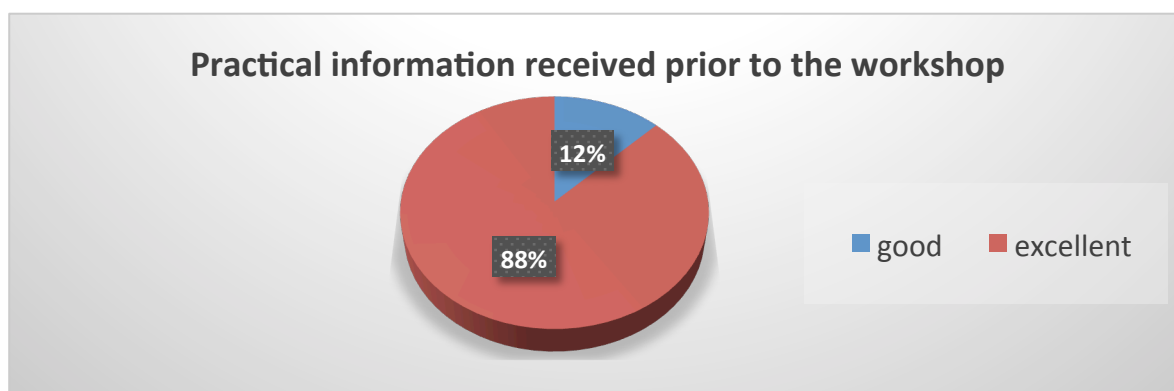
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The second workshop on internationalisation of the curriculum (IoC) (Work Package 3, **deliverable 3.1**) took place at Beit Berl College in Israel on January 28-30, 2014. CHE Consult conducted an evaluation of the workshop by developing a survey to assess the quality of the workshop and its outcomes. This report will focus on an assessment of the practical arrangements of the workshop.

RESULTS OF THE SURVEY

The majority of the participants found the invitation and registration procedure for the workshop good or excellent. Participants were also very satisfied with the practical information received prior to the workshop – 53% of participants rated them as excellent.

In general, on the scale from 1 to 4, the workshop overall was rated **3.7**, with 27% of participants evaluating it as “good” and 73% as “excellent”. **The organisation of the workshop was rated very highly (average ratings of 3.8)**. Respondents were also very satisfied with the premises and facilities at the host institution and meals provided during the workshop.
