To improve the academic quality as well as the status and competitiveness of public colleges vis-à-vis universities and private colleges through the development of internationalism capabilities and culture at the colleges.







#### **IRIS Objectives**

- 1. Development of a strategic plan for internationalization of academic colleges, taking into considerations national context, societal interests and the diversification, constraints and priorities of academic colleges in Israel.
- 2. Infusing colleges' campuses with an international perspective and encouraging the engagement of faculty, administrators and students in the internationalization agenda.







#### **IRIS Objectives**

- 3. Development and delivery of training for international relations professionals in the partner colleges.
- 4. Establishment of International Relations Offices (IRO) in the partner colleges.
- 5. Development of pilot activities by the trained local IRO teams.
- 6. Establishment of a network of IROs for advocacy of internationalization programs, the transfer of best practices, and further collaborative initiatives.



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- ✓ WP 1 : Requirement analysis and benchmarking completed.
  - A questionnaire survey was conducted in each of the 7 colleges and the Presidents were interviewed. The results were published.
  - 2 papers were written and submitted for publication.
  - A workshop for benchmarking deliverable 1.3 was cancelled.
  - 2 days study visits by Israeli college representatives in EU partner IROs
  - Dr. Fiona Hunter and Prof. Hans de-Wit presented "Strategies for internationalization" during the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of the consortium meeting.





- ✓ WP 2 : Internationalization strategic plan –
  (almost) completed.
  - 2 successful workshop for internationalization took place (in Al-Qasemi College and in Shenkar College).
  - The colleges are developing their strategic plan for internationalization.
  - Strategic plan on national level will be developed with the colleges, Varam and NUIS. It will be submitted to the Israeli CHE. To Be Discussed.
  - Feedback sessions with colleges (04-05/12/2013).
  - Colleges Presidents meeting (05/12/2013).
  - Final drafts of Internationalization Strategic Plans by January 15<sup>th</sup> 2014.





- WP 3: Development and delivery of campus internationalization programs for faculty, administrators and students - starting.
  - Planned E-learning workshop and toolkit for faculty was cancelled.
  - A workshop for faculty curriculum internationalization (Kaye college, 18-20/11/2013) - completed.
  - 2 workshops are planned for the next months:
     Beit Berl college, 28-30/01/2014.
     Ort Braude college, 26-28/05/2014.





- WP 4: Development and delivery of training activities for the qualification of IRO professionals - will start soon.
  - 5 IRO training workshops (2 in Israel, 1 in Italy, 1 in Austria, 1 in Poland)
  - IRO toolkits/Professional development guides will be developed.
- WPs 5 (Pilot IRO activities) and 8 (Exploitation and Sustainability) will start during the 2<sup>nd</sup> year of the project.
- WPs 6 (Quality assurance), 7 (dissemination) & 9 (project management) include ongoing tasks.
